## SOS Announces Absentee Voting and Other Election Information

SANTA FE – Pursuant to the requirements of Section 1-6-5(J) NMSA 1978, New Mexico Secretary of State Maggie Toulouse Oliver announced today that county clerks will begin sending absentee ballots on Tuesday, May 8 to voters who have successfully completed the absentee application process.

## Below is a timeline of important election dates:

Tuesday, May 8  Saturday, May 10	Last day to register to vote in the Primary Election. County clerks will begin sending absentee ballots. In-person voting will be available at each county clerk's office during normal business hours. In Bernalillo County, in-person voting will be available at the Clerk's Annex. Countywide early voting begins.
May 19 Friday, June 1	Last day for county clerks to send absentee ballots to voters.
Saturday, June 2	Last day of countywide early voting.
Tuesday, June 5	Primary Election Day.  Last day for voters to return an absentee ballot to their county clerk's office or an Election Day polling location.

Voters may view a <u>listing of contact information for county clerks</u> on the Secretary of State's website to find information on polling locations and their hours of operation.
