SOS Toulouse Oliver Reminds New Mexico that Early Voting Begins Saturday, May 19

SANTA FE – New Mexico Secretary of State Maggie Toulouse Oliver reminds New Mexicans that early voting in the 2018 Primary Election begins tomorrow, Saturday, May 19.

"Early voting makes it easier to fit voting into our busy lives," said Secretary Toulouse Oliver. "I want all New Mexico voters to be aware of all the voting options available to them so no one misses their chance to participate in the electoral process. Voters should visit <u>NMVote.org</u> to find a list of voting locations in their county and their hours of operation."

Early voting will be available at multiple locations in counties with more than ten thousand voters every Monday through Saturday until Saturday, June 2. In counties with fewer than ten thousand voters, early voting will be available only at the county clerk's office.

County clerks began sending absentee ballots to voters who have successfully completed the absentee application process on Tuesday, May 8, and will continue sending ballots to those voters until Friday, June 1. May 8 was also the first day of in-person voting at each county clerk's office.

Election Day is Tuesday, June 5. Voters can also visit <u>NMVote.org</u> to request an absentee ballot, download a sample ballot, view important election dates and more.
