## 2024 NOMINATING PETITION CALCULATIONS

### Introduction

This publication has been prepared by the Bureau of Elections to serve as a reference for candidates seeking office in the 2024 Primary Election. This publication contains information regarding nominating petition calculations pursuant to Article 9 of the New Mexico Election Code. While independent and minor party candidates do not participate in the Primary Election, they may be required to circulate petitions and file declarations of candidacy shortly following the Primary Election (a supplemental publication with those calculations will be available in 2024).
